





Early Childhood Teaching and Ministry Overview

Train your new teachers in-house with 25 free online modules.

TIER 2

CDA Credential Training

Earn a CDA in one semester.

TIER 3

Early Childhood Ministry Certification

Obtain theology and ministry training appropriate for early childhood.

TIER 4

Associate of Science in Early Childhood Education

Become call eligible for preschool with a college degree and ministry certification.
