


Our mission is to reflect Christ's love and compassion to souls suffering from disasters and hardships (mercy/compassion ministry).

• Through May of FY24-25, we utilized \$417,807 for disaster relief.



International Disaster Relief

- Helped to rebuild several churches in Malawi.
- Assisted victims of flooding in India, Kenya, Thailand, and Vietnam.
- Gave aid to victims of persecution in Pakistan, war in Myanmar, and an earthquake in Nepal.



Wildfires



 We helped WELS congregations assist those impacted by wildfires in Texas, on the San Carlos reservation in Arizona, and in Los Angeles.

Hurricanes Helene and Milton

 We assisted congregations and members in Florida, Tennessee, and in North Carolina with cleanup and recovery efforts following hurricanes Helene and Milton.

• Through May of FY24-25 we utilized \$328,915 for personal relief grants.




Personal Relief Grants
